

TERMS OF REFERENCE: HARTON ACADEMY LOCAL GOVERNING BODY

This document is based on the Trust's Scheme of Delegation that states the responsibilities will be:

- Building an understanding of how the school is led and managed
- Monitoring whether the school is:
 - Working within agreed policies
 - Is meeting the agreed targets
 - Managing its finances well
- Engaging with stakeholders
- Reporting to the Board

The Local Governing Body will:

- 1. Submit the CEO/Executive Head Teacher's Report to the next meeting of the Trust Board following the termly meeting of the Local Governing Body.
- 2. Agree the budget plan to support delivery of school key priorities.
- 3. Complete a skills audit and recruit to fill gaps.
- 4. Complete an annual self-review of Local Governing Body performance.
- 5. Consider succession planning of the Local Governing Body.
- 6. Agree an annual schedule of business for the Local Governing Body.
- 7. Agree auditing & reporting arrangements for matters of compliance (e.g. safeguarding, Health & Safety, employment).
- 8. Agree reporting arrangements for progress on key priorities.
- 9. Receive and respond to the External Auditor's report.
- 10. Ensure robustness via benchmarking and school/academy value for money.
- 11. Be responsible for the appointment of school posts.
- 12. Ensure the curriculum complies with the legal and funding agreement requirements.
- 13. Ensure behaviour policy is applied consistently.
- 14. Determine and apply attendance and punctuality protocols and procedures.
- 15. Be responsible for excluding a pupil (permanently) and hearing any appeals.

Common Conventions for Committees

How and when to report back to the Local Governing Body

Minutes to be presented to the next appropriate meeting of the full Local Governing Body. The Committee Chair will report to the Local Governing Body.

Meetings to be called, agenda prepared, minutes taken

Meetings to be convened by the Executive Head Teacher/CEO in consultation with the Chair of the Committee and the Leadership & Governance Manager.

Agenda to be prepared by the Leadership & Governance Manager and distributed together with any supporting papers.

Minutes to be taken by the Leadership & Governance Manager.

Quorum for all committees is 3 Governors who are members of the committee.

The Chair of the committee will be appointed at the beginning of every meeting of that committee.

To provide advice and support to the Trust Board who are accountable for the appointment.

Appointment of all other Trust Central Team Staff

Appointment by CEO.
