We're excited to be able to provide young people (14+) with SEND in South Tyneside with the opportunity to share their views on the SEND Green Paper as part of the SEND Review. Your views will be sent to the Government which will help them in making decisions about how young people are supported in the future.

Sessions will take place virtually, on Microsoft Teams. Don't worry if you're not used to using this, we can provide help with this!

What is the SEND Review?

The SEND review sets out government's proposals for a system that offers children and young people the opportunity to thrive, with access to the **right support**, in the **right place**, and at the **right time**, so they can fulfil their potential and lead happy, healthy and productive adult lives.

What does taking-part include?

There'll be a range of sessions taking place from now until the end of June 2022. Some of these sessions will be led by representatives from the Council for Disabled Children and KIDS, who support young people with special educational needs and/or disabilities, while others will be co-produced with members of the SENDIASS team.
